Magnetic & Gravitational Fields and Climate Change

Thomas, an Inventor, Researcher & Author comes from a family of Inventors. He has written two books; *A Fresh Approach to Magnetism* in 2006 and *Climate Change and Magnetism* in 2009. His interests in magnetism and the magnetic effects related to gravity were first kindled when he saw a UFO over Ballarat in 1991. He has designed and built magnetic motors which are 98% efficient and has used his knowledge to further research the atomic nature of magnetism.

Thomas has found a new common ratio of the Electron to its Nucleus for all atoms, as having the same scientific value as science accepts and knows as Gravity. He has established a new understanding of how the emissions from a common bar magnet stem from each pole and not as Fleming's 'Continuous Magnetic Law' states as flowing from North Pole to the South Pole. He has also established a geometric evaluation method to determine the gravity value of a site by only using and applying the latitude and elevation above Sea Level in this mathematics. Using his discoveries, he has demonstrated weight loss in an experiment where a rotating device lost 14 pounds of its own weight while rotating, and lastly most recently designed a 1.5 Kw electric magnetic motor with all component body parts made from plastic.
